Sûrat Al-Mâ'ûn
(The Small Kindnesses) CVII

*In the Name of Allâh,
the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.*

1. Have you seen him who denies the Recompense?
2. That is he who repulses the orphan (harshly),^[1]
3. And urges not on the feeding of *Al-Miskîn* (the needy),^[2]
4. So woe to those performers of *Salât* (prayers) (hypocrites),
5. Those who delay their *Salât* (prayers from their stated fixed times).^[3]
6. Those who do good deeds only to be seen (of men),
7. And withhold *Al-Mâ'ûn* (small kindnesses like salt, sugar, water).

Sûrat Al-Kauthar
(A River in Paradise) CVIII

*In the Name of Allâh,
the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.*

1. Verily, We have granted you (O Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم) *Al-Kauthar* (a river in Paradise).^[4]

^[1] (V.107:2) Narrated Sahl bin Sa'd رضى الله عنهما: The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم said, "I and the person who looks after an orphan and provides for him, will be in Paradise like this," putting his index and middle fingers together. (*Sahîh Al-Bukhârî*, Vol.8, *Hadîth* No.34).

^[2] (V.107:3) Narrated Abu Hurairah رضى الله عنه: The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم said, "The one who looks after a widow or a poor person is like a *Mujâhid* (fighter) who fights for Allâh's Cause, or like him who performs prayers all the night and fasts all the day." (*Sahîh Al-Bukhârî*, Vol.7, *Hadîth* No.265).

^[4] (V.108:1) Narrated Anas رضى الله عنه: When the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم was made to ascend to the heavens. He صلى الله عليه وسلم said (after his return), "I came upon a river (in Paradise) the banks of which were made of tents of hollow pearls. I asked Jibrîl (Gabriel), 'What is this (river)?' He replied, 'This is *Al-Kauthar*.'" (*Sahîh Al-Bukhârî*, Vol.6, *Hadîth* No. 488).

2. Therefore turn in prayer to your Lord and sacrifice (to Him only).

3. For he who hates you (O Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم), he will be cut off (from posterity and every good thing in this world and in the Hereafter).^[1]

Sûrat Al-Kâfirûn
(The Disbelievers) CIX

In the Name of Allâh,
the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

1. Say: (O Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم to these *Mushrikûn* and *Kafirûn*): “O *Al-Kâfirûn* (disbelievers in Allâh, in His Oneness, in His Angels, in His Books, in His Messengers, in the Day of Resurrection, and in *Al-Qadar*.)!

2. I worship not that which you worship,

3. Nor will you worship that which I worship.

4. And I shall not worship that which you are worshipping,

5. Nor will you worship that which I worship.

6. To you be your religion, and to me my religion (Islâmic Monotheism).”

Sûrat An-Nasr (The Help) CX

In the Name of Allâh,
the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

1. When there comes the Help of Allâh (to you, O Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم against your enemies) and the conquest (of Makkah).

2. And you see that the people enter Allâh’s religion (Islâm) in crowds.

3. So glorify the Praises of your Lord, and ask His Forgiveness. Verily, He is the One Who Ever accepts the repentance and Who forgives.
